COMPANY I, 502 PARACHUTE INFANTRY

IT IS WITH REGRET THAT WE INFORM YOU OF THE DEATH OF FRANK L. LILLYMAN, LT. COLONEL RETIRED. FRANK WAS A FORMER COMPANY I COMMANDER AND AT THE TIME OF THE INVASION OF NORMANDY WAS COMMANDER OF THE 502 PATHFINDERS WHO WERE THE FIRST ALLIED SOLDIERS TO LAND IN FRANCE. FRANK DIED ON MARCH 6, 1971 AT WALTER REED HOSPITAL, THE VICTIM OF A STROKE. HE WAS 55 YEARS OLD. CARDS AND LETTERS WITH WORDS OF SYMPATHY AND ENCOURAGEMENT WOULD BE GREATLY APPRECIATED BY HIS FAMILY.
